



Poly Spots Games



Locomotor Shuffle – Tape a different movement word, (run, jump, leap, skip, etc.) on each PolySpot. Players start on a polyspot, when the whistle blows, or music starts they begin moving around the room doing that movement. When the signal is given they need to go stand on a Polyspot, then they do that movement, and so on.

Hot Shot – Place Polyspots around the room. Players shoot a Finger Rocket (or throw a Rubber Animal) and try to land on it. Each Polyspot has a predetermined point value.

Musical Chairs – Play musical chairs but use the Polyspots. Each Polyspot has a paper taped to the bottom. The paper can have a number that coincides with a spelling word on a list, a funny thing to do, use your imagination.

Shuffle – Split the players into 2 teams with each team having 2 Polyspots. They need to go from point A to point B stepping on the Polyspots. This means they will have to pick one up, put it in front of them, and step on it and grab the second one and move it.

Shoot' Em Up– Line up plastic bottles, cups, or boxes along a table or fence. Using Finger Rockets the players shoot them down.

Variation: Use rubber animals.

Variation: Using the Polyspots, suspend by putting a duct tape “tab” with a hole in it, and run fishing line or string through the hole to hang.

Bases – yes, you can even use them as bases and markers for all of your games.
